

Reasons for Remand - M.D.N.C. January 1, 2012 - December 31, 2013

- (1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision (8 cases).
- (2) ALJs findings contradictory and ambiguous (3 cases).
- (3) Remand due to new evidence (2 cases).
- (4) ALJ relied on Grids when there was a nonexertional impairment (2 cases).
- (5) ALJ failed to resolved conflict between VE's testimony and DOT (1 case).

7	Webster (M)	Weaver v. Colvin 1:10-cv-582	(1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision. (5) ALJ failed to resolved conflict between VE's testimony and DOT.
8	Webster (M)	Huffman v. Colvin 1:10-cv-537	(1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision.
9	Eagles (J)	Boler v. Colvin 1:10-cv-451	(1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision. (4) ALJ relied on Grids when there was a nonexertional impairment.
10	Webster (M)	Wilson-Coleman v. Colvin 1:11-cv-726	(3) Remand due to new evidence.

11	Eagles (J)	Cobb v. Colvin 1:11-cv-230	(1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision.
12	Peake (M)	Melvin v. Colvin 1:9-cv-174	(1) Substantial evidence did NOT support ALJ's decision. (3) Remand due to new evidence.
